

#### KA6U's Grid Square Tour Continuing

On August 8<sup>th</sup> Peter was one month on the road, activating wanted grid squares. Since he left his home in Florida he visited 12 US States, activated 9 unique grid squares with a total of 11 activations altogether to help hams collecting the states for the WAS award. KA6U made 560 complete QSOs (as of August 8<sup>th</sup>, now he may be close to 700). Peter writes that his original plan for the trip was to visit 25 states, activate 20 grids and complete 2000 QSOs. Hence, he is already between roughly 25 and 50 % on target. Since he is planning for at least 2 ½ more months – which makes it end of October – there is a good chance he may well exceed his plan.

Some 75 people visited his station and asked what Peter was doing. People have been very friendly and curious. And speaking with many different accents – the USA are a big country. Peter even started to give QSL cards to visitors.

Peter uploads all QSOs to LoTW but recently found a way for those looking for paper QSL cards: Ian Parker W6TCP has offered to act as a QSL manager for paper QSLs.

When looking for a good QTH in FN51 Peter was invited to become QRV from the grounds of the historic Chatham Marconi Maritime Center: <u>https://www.wccara.com/wcc</u> That site was built in 1914 by the Marconi company. Because of World War I, it was never activated by Marconi. It is situated on the Western Side of Cape Cod, a peninsular East of Boston, right at the Atlantic.

The blog site also supports the ability for viewers to post comments. Besides qrz.com he he'll post also there all upcoming activation dates, locations and logs. Consequently, the new blog is the only place you would need to look.



The phot on the left was taken at the Marconi site. The station is an actual working station built in the late 1950's and used aboard the Hospital Ship USS Hope. It outputs a very conservative 200 W and the museum regularly operates the station on 40 M CW. On Peter's blog you can see more photos from the Marconi site and other locations he was active from.


